The products are interpreted by the most important contemporary designers, from Yabu Pushelberg to Foster + Partners, from Ron Gilad and Gio Ponti.

La natura è parte integrante del nostro modo di vivere: una connessione volta a ritrovare il tempo perduto delle stagioni e dei colori, riscoprire il vivere all'aria aperta, accompagnati da arredi e oggetti pensati per spazi accoglienti. Una libertà quanto mai ricercata, una sensibilità — quella del vivere *en plein air* — che ha molto a che fare con il rispetto per la natura e con il concetto di sostenibilità. La nuova proposta Outdoor trae ispirazione dall'esclusività dell'eccellenza italiana, ricercata e raffinata. Caratteristiche proprie anche dell'universo creativo del direttore artistico Vincent Van Duysen, che ha coordinato due ampie collezioni che si arricchiscono ogni anno di nuovi pezzi firmati dai più prestigiosi designer contemporanei, da Foster + Partners a Ron Gilad, da Yabu Pushelberg a Gio Ponti.

Landmark, the collection characterized by solid teak, is harmoniously designed to allow outdoor spaces to be experienced with comfort and elegance. It is a true milestone, a reverence that enhances Molteni&C's mastery in magnifying natural elements into furniture with timeless appeal. The **Fairmount** table in solid teak is Vincent Van Duysen's testament to magnificently transferring the art of living from indoor to outdoor spaces and can be complemented with two seating solutions, **Cobea** and **Boboli**. The **Sway** modular sofa system by Yabu Pushelberg, with its unmistakably soft and fluid lines, evokes an immersive and engaging experience inspired by the layering concept suggested by nature.

The **Timeout Collection**, instead, features metal as the predominant material. A reference to modernist architecture, where the apparently cold character is mitigated by its fine lines.

A contemporary interpretation of metal, softened by the intertwined ropes of the backrests or the natural materials of the various elements as in the **Petalò** armchair by Vincent Van Duysen, with its masterful weaving of ecru polypropylene ropes.

Noteworthy is the introduction of ceramics in the **Picea** coffee table — a sculptural monobloc offered in anthracite, merlot red, and ecru.

Molteni&C's two outdoor collections are independent but dialogue with each other, with materials playing a starring role, where solid natural teak engages in a dialogue with aluminum profiles.

The dialogue continues with mutual and sophisticated references in the details and in the common color palette, which reflects typically Mediterranean colors, from the warm earthy tones to the hues of olive groves, including merlot red and golden-hours hues that complement the handcrafted polypropylene ropes. The same shades are featured in the rug selection, offering creations by Marta Ferri, Nicola Gallizia and Vincent Van Duysen that add an extra touch of elegance to the outdoor experience.

To enrich the outdoor proposal, a series of timeless elements with a common charm, such as the **Arc** table of Foster + Partners, the **Panna Cotta** coffee table by Ron Gilad and two important projects by Gio Ponti, part of Molteni&C's **Heritage Collection**: the iconic **D.154.2** which finds a new identity and use in its outdoor version, and the **D.150.5** solid wood chaise longue, designed for the cruise ship *Andrea Doria* in 1952.

Landmark, collezione caratterizzata dal massello in teak, è armonicamente studiata per permettere di vivere con comfort ed eleganza gli spazi esterni, esprimendosi attraverso un carattere materico ed emozionale. Il tavolo **Fairmount** di Vincent Van Duysen continua il percorso di connessione tra interno ed esterno e può essere arricchito con le sedute **Cobea** e **Boboli**. Il divano modulare **Sway** di Yabu Pushelberg è una sinfonia di forme e linee ondulate che trae ispirazione dal concetto di stratificazione suggerito dalla natura.

La Collezione **Timeout** è invece caratterizzata dal metallo come materiale predominante.

Un richiamo alle architetture moderniste, dove il carattere apparentemente freddo viene addolcito dalle sue linee sottili.


Un'interpretazione contemporanea del metallo, ingentilito dagli intrecci delle corde degli schienali o dai materiali naturali dei vari elementi, come nella poltrona **Petalò** di Vincent Van Duysen con i suoi intrecci di corde in polipropilene ecru.

Degna di nota, l'introduzione del tavolino **Picea**, elemento scultoreo dai toni antracite, merlot red ed ecru.

Le due collezioni Outdoor di Molteni&C sono indipendenti ma dialogano tra di loro grazie a reciproci e sofisticati richiami nei dettagli e nella paletta cromatica comune, che riporta a colori tipicamente mediterranei con le sfumature calde della terra e le cromie degli uliveti, come le tinte merlot-red e golden-hour che si combinano ai toni delle corde intrecciate di polipropilene.

Le stesse tonalità vengono proposte nei tappeti: creazioni firmate da Marta Ferri, Nicola Gallizia e Vincent Van Duysen, regalano un ulteriore tocco di eleganza all'esperienza outdoor.

Ad impreziosire la proposta Outdoor, una serie di elementi comuni dal fascino senza tempo come il tavolo **Arc** di Foster + Partners o il tavolino **Panna Cotta** di Ron Gilad, appositamente studiato per essere esposto all'esterno. Si aggiungono inoltre due importanti progetti di Gio Ponti, che arricchiscono l'**Heritage Collection**: l'iconica **D.154.2** che, già nel catalogo indoor, trova un'inedita identità nella sua versione outdoor, e la chaise longue **D.150.5** in legno massello, progettata da Gio Ponti per la nave da crociera *Andrea Doria* nel 1952.



LANDMARK COLLECTION

Landmark takes shape from fluid, organic lines, and the distinct materiality of the elements.

A design without corners, characterized by the woven teak wood motif, EVA polyurethane and polypropylene, that circumscribes the back, embracing the material with comfort and design. Everything is softened and cozy: the furnishings are soft to the touch, the structures have no edges, even in the connections between seat and supportive frame.

The wooden elements are rich in details, curves and joints of high cabinet making, thus enhancing their sculptural forms. They reflect the Molteni&C DNA, which stems precisely from the working of wood, here reinterpreted through a design that can express the wisdom and skill of tradition with a contemporary aesthetic language, drawing inspiration from the lessons of the leading architects who have worked with the Company in interpreting wood. Like Luca Meda, to whom homage is paid with the production of *Palinfrasca*, the sofa inspired by a 1994 work by the architect.

Integrating seamlessly into this collection are the Fairmount Table by Vincent Van Duysen, meticulously crafted from exquisite solid teak, and the Sway Modular Sofa System by Yabu Pushelberg, a groundbreaking outdoor ensemble with unparalleled versatility and fluid forms.

Complementing these are the Cobea Chair and the Boboli Armchair and Sofa, both designed by Vincent Van Duysen, showcasing exceptional craftsmanship and embodying the qualities of rarity and preciousness.

Each piece adds its unique charm, enhancing the Landmark Collection with a harmonious blend of comfort, style, and meticulous design.

Landmark prende forma da linee fluide e organiche e dalla spiccata matericità degli elementi. Un disegno senza angoli, caratterizzato dal motivo intrecciato in legno di teak o poliuretano EVA, che circoscrive lo schienale, per abbracciare con confort e design. Tutto è ingentilito e accogliente: gli arredi sono morbidi al tatto, le strutture prive di spigli, perfino nei raccordi tra seduta e struttura portante.

Gli elementi in legno sono ricchi di dettagli, curvature e incastri di alta ebanisteria, risaltandone così le forme scultoree. Rispecchiano il DNA di Molteni&C che nasce proprio dalla lavorazione del legno in essenza, qui riletto attraverso un design che sa interpretare la sapienza e la maestria della tradizione con un linguaggio estetico attuale, traendo spunto dalla lezione dei protagonisti dell'architettura che hanno interpretato il legno insieme all'Azienda. Come Luca Meda, al quale viene reso omaggio con la produzione di *Palinfrasca*, il divano che trae ispirazione proprio da un'opera del 1994 firmata dall'architetto.

Integrati alla perfezione nella collezione, il tavolo Fairmount di Vincent Van Duysen, ideato e realizzato in pregiato teak massello, e il divano modulare Sway di Yabu Pushelberg che ridefinisce i confini degli spazi outdoor grazie alla versatilità, la componibilità e la fluidità delle forme.

A complemento, la sedia Cobea e la poltrona e divano Boboli, entrambi di Vincent Van Duysen, pezzi curati che incarnano le qualità di rarità e preziosità.

Ogni pezzo dal fascino unico arricchisce la Collezione Landmark con un armonioso mix di comfort, stile e design meticoloso.

TIMEOUT COLLECTION

The **Timeout Collection** the theme of metal, presenting it in a modern way on a range of furnishings: two-seater sofa, armchair, chair, sunbed, stool, bench, low table and dining table - to define plein air environments or spaces half indoors and half outdoors.

Van Duysen draws his inspiration from the tradition of fer forgé, reserving for the metal a formal precision and purity that recalls elegant, modernist languages. The coldness of aluminum is warmed by the burnished paint, a color that evokes the natural world, such as the browns of earth, lit up by warmer tones.

The proposal is distinguished by the aluminum band which, continuously bending, creates the support structure, the armrests, and the support feet. The 'woven' theme becomes purely evocative in the metal, linked to the idea of movement rather than mere form, minimal without losing its material sensuality. Instead, the "weaving" becomes explicit in the upholstery of the structure, made of a weave of polyethylene fibre ribbons masterfully executed by hand.

The **Timeout Collection** seamlessly integrates the gentle curves and enveloping backrest of the Petalo Armchair and Pouf by Vincent Van Duysen, redefining outdoor elegance. Additionally, the Picea Outdoor Coffee Table by Van Duysen, crafted in ceramic with rounded lines, adds durability and subtle grace, setting the tone for sophisticated moments spent in nature.

La Collezione Timeout interpreta il tema del metallo, declinandolo in modo moderno in tutta la ricca proposta di arredi, come: divano a due posti, poltrona con o senza braccioli, sedia con o senza braccioli, lettino, sgabello, panca, tavolino basso e tavolo da pranzo - per definire ambienti plein air o spazi tra in e outdoor.

Van Duysen trae ispirazione dalla tradizione del fer forgé, riservando al metallo un rigore formale e una purezza che rimanda a linguaggi eleganti e modernisti. La freddezza dell'alluminio è riscaldata dalla verniciatura color brunito, cromia che richiama il mondo naturale, come i marroni della terra, accesa da tonalità più calde.

La proposta si distingue per la fascia in alluminio che, piegandosi senza interrompersi, crea la struttura di sostegno, i braccioli e i piedini d'appoggio. Il tema dell'intreccio diventa nella parte metallica puramente evocativo: legato all'idea di movimento anziché alla mera forma, minimale senza perdere la sensualità materica. Il "weaving" diviene invece esplicito nel rivestimento della struttura, realizzato con un intreccio, eseguito magistralmente a mano, di nastri in fibra di polietilene.

La Collezione Timeout integra le forme dolcemente tondeggianti e avvolgenti della poltrona e del pouf Petalo di Vincent Van Duysen, ridefinendo l'eleganza dell'outdoor. Degno di nota, il tavolino Picea di Van Duysen, un oggetto integralmente in ceramica e dalle linee armoniose e finemente arrotondate. Il tavolino risulta di perfetta compagnia nei più svariati momenti trascorsi all'aria aperta.



A union between architecture and nature

"For me, Karl Blossfeldt's work represents an important link between architecture and nature. It is the same link that I wanted to include in the elements of this outdoor proposal.

His subjects - flowers, plants, botanical elements - are the perfect match to juxtapose with the furnishings of the two new collections. For the interpretation of this union, I decided to rely on the creative flair of the photographer Frederik Vercruyse, who, with his minimalist approach, has captured with great purity the organic and sinuous forms of the elements of the collections, which find a perfect match in the world of botany".

Through his works, Karl Blossfeldt was able to transcend the medium of expression, rendering images that translate into a universal artistic language, where lines and shapes become a synthesis of expression and iconography.

Thanks to his meticulous talent, he managed to introduce the sculptural dimension into a typically two-dimensional art form such as photography, using the world of botany as his main subject.

Elegant, refined, contemplative; Blossfeldt's shots, in their immediate elegance, render unseen natural details that still today inspire awe and admiration in the beholder.

Nature, like architecture and every other art form, can educate us in beauty and interiority.
